The desired "No Objection Certificate" in respect of following facts is being issued:-

- (13) Number of Ayurved practitioners registered with the State Council / Board of Indian Systems of Medicine:-**14859**
- (14) Number of Ayurved practitioners in State Government Service:-**970**
- (15) Number of vacant Government posts of Ayurved doctors in the State, particularly in rural / difficult areas:- **710**

- (17) Ayurved doctors-population ratio in the state:- **1:4933**
- (18) How the establishment of the New Ayurved medical college starting BAMS course would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State ? Starting BAMS course in the new institution will improve the availability of the graduate Ayurved doctors in the State to enter service because the ratio of the total available Ayurved Graduate doctors to Under Graduate doctors is very low.
- (19) The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State be specified- **As per rules.**
- (20) Full justification for opening of the proposed Ayurved medical college starting new course.

President. Ayushmati Education and Social Society, Bhopal (M.P.) has applied for establishment of R. N. Kapoor Memorial Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital, Indore. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Madhya Pradesh has decided to issue "No Objection Certificate" to the applicant for the establishment of the proposed ayurved medical college starting BAMS course with 100 seats admission capacity, subject to the condition that the **applicant society shall fulfill all requirements as per relevant regulations, before visitation by CCIM.**

It is certified that:-

- (d) The applicant owns and manages a 100 bedded hospital which has been established in the year 2015.
- (e) It is desirable to establish an Ayurved college in the public interest.
- (f) Establishment of Ayurved college/ starting BAMS course at Indore is feasible.


It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per the norms of the Central Council of Indian medicine is available with the proposed Medical College. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurved college as per the Central Council of Indian medicine norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
